- Linear that all employees and sub-contractors are competent to carry out their duties and tasks, through experience or training.
- 4 Provide and maintain suitable plant and equipment, and implement arrangements for the safe use, handling, storage, and transportation of articles and substances.
- 4 Aim to prevent accidents injury and work- related ill health, and ensure the implementation of arrangements to report review, monitor, and investigate any accident near misses of work related ill-health.
- To communicate the content of this policy, which will be reviewed annually, and the occupational health and safety management system to all persons working under our control, and to make sure that all employees are made aware of their individual health and safety responsibilities.

To reinforce these policy commitments, integrated management systems which conform to the requirements of ISO 9001: 2008; ISO 14001: 2004; ISO 27001: 2013 and OHSAS 18001:2007 operate throughout the company. We are committed to the continuous improvement of the integrated management system. We will, through continuous improvement, ensure that the company operates effectively and efficiently and remains focused on the needs of our customers and stakeholders. The effectiveness of the management systems are monitored and reviewed through planned audits, and periodic management review.
